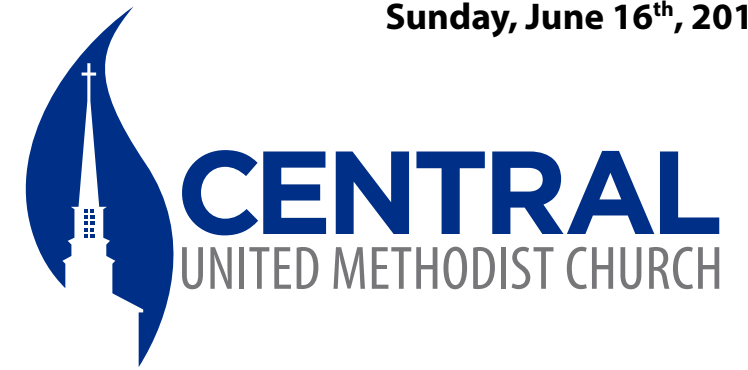

Barna says, "In a culture saturated with change, one of the most stable aspects in the religious sphere has been Sunday School... Why? More than ever before, people need a counterweight to the massive cultural shifts that modern societies are now experiencing. More specifically, children need Sunday School ministry for FIVE reasons.
