Join us for **SUNDAY SCHOOL** at 9:45am! Sunday Schools may seem like "old hat" to some... but according to Barna Research, 95% of churches still offer some type of classroom Bible teaching– and for good reason. Barna says, "In a culture saturated with change, one of the most stable aspects in the religious sphere has been Sunday School... Why? More than ever before, people need a counterweight to the massive cultural shifts that modern societies are now experiencing. More specifically, children need Sunday School ministry for FIVE reasons. (Adapted from: <https://ministry-to-children.com/why-we-need-sunday-school-ministry/>) Previously we learned #1: Sunday School helps children respect, appreciate and utilize the Bible. #2: Sunday School teaches children how to navigate the Bible. #3: Sunday School gives kids a chance to ask questions. # 4: Sunday School develops a community of believers. Why do you think schools use the classroom method? Not just to reach more children, faster. Originally, it was because in a classroom setting, kids were more likely to help one another and push each other along in their growth. A community of children, worshipping, learning the Bible and discovering God together creates a bond that single study can't accomplish. Sunday Schools are the Petri dishes for the future church. 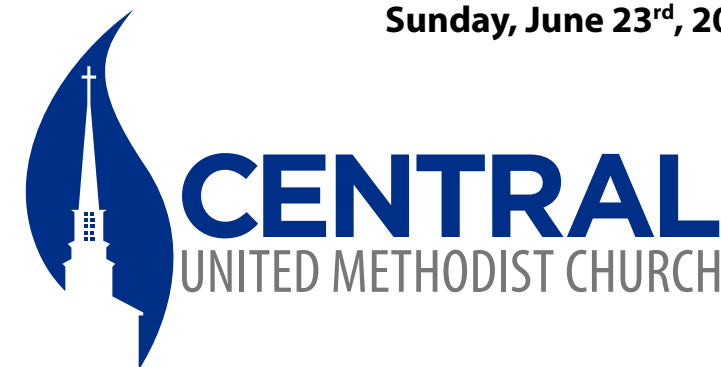
