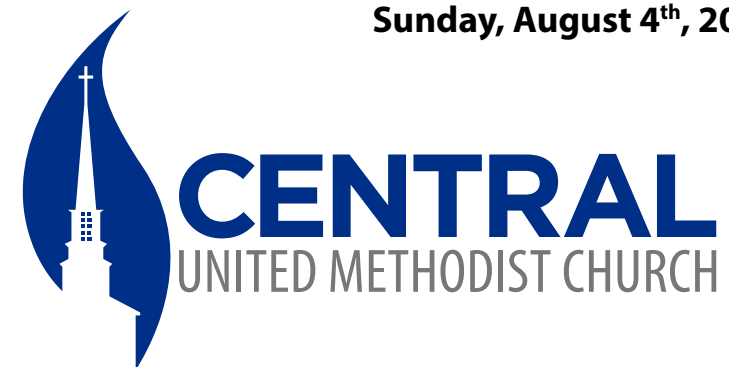
If you have a rising 3rd Grader, please let us know. The Children's Ministry would like to give the gift of God's Word to your child to honor this special time of transition.
