I did want to share with you what the children learned during our devotion times...as it's a good reminder for everyone!

1) Foundation – Jesus is our foundation...the basis on which we make every decision; everything must be built on Jesus!

2) Door/Overhang – Jesus is our only way to heaven. He is our one true Shepherd; we hear His voice and we follow as His sheep. He is always present with us, 'hanging over us'.

3) Walls – God is our protection; His Word tells us that He is like a ring of fire around us...it never burns us but protects us from the enemy. Zechariah 2:5

4) Windows – God is El Roi...The God who sees. There are 'windows' from heaven in which God is always watching us. He always knows the joy we experience, as well as the pain and struggle we endure. But how does God see you? He sees you as a child of His...holy, good and beautiful...His special creation.

5) Roof/Housetop – The housetop was used in very diverse ways during Jesus' time on earth, but we focused on people going up on their roof to worship and pray to God. We focused on the importance of worship, in various forms (music, dance, prayer, words of affirmation, etc.). God desires for His people to worship Him!!!

6) Mailbox – Communication!!! God still communicates with His people today! It may not be an audible voice but He communicates through the Bible, through nature/creation, through other believers, through music, through circumstances in your life and through the Holy Spirit!

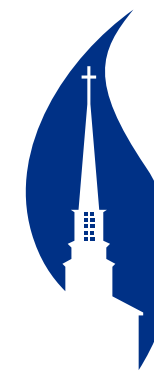

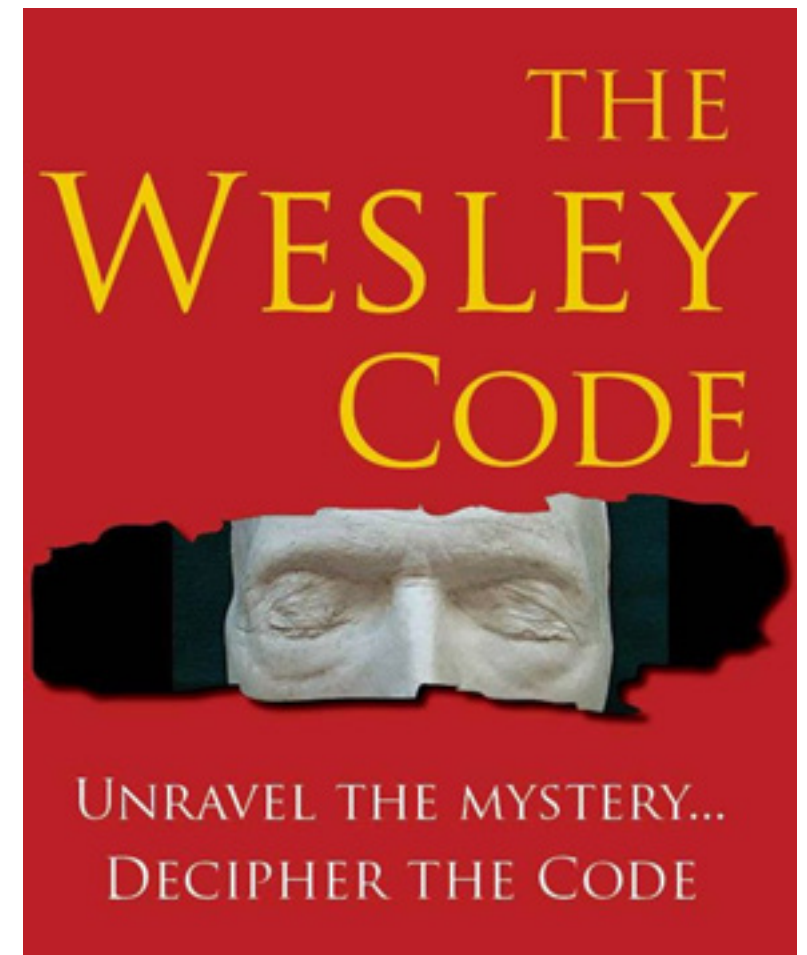

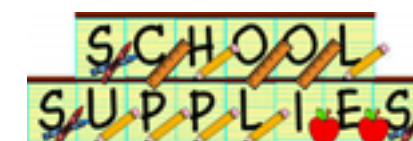
