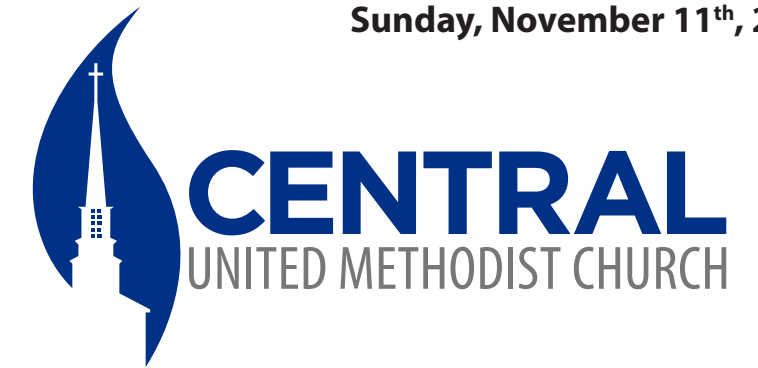

YOUTH NEWS

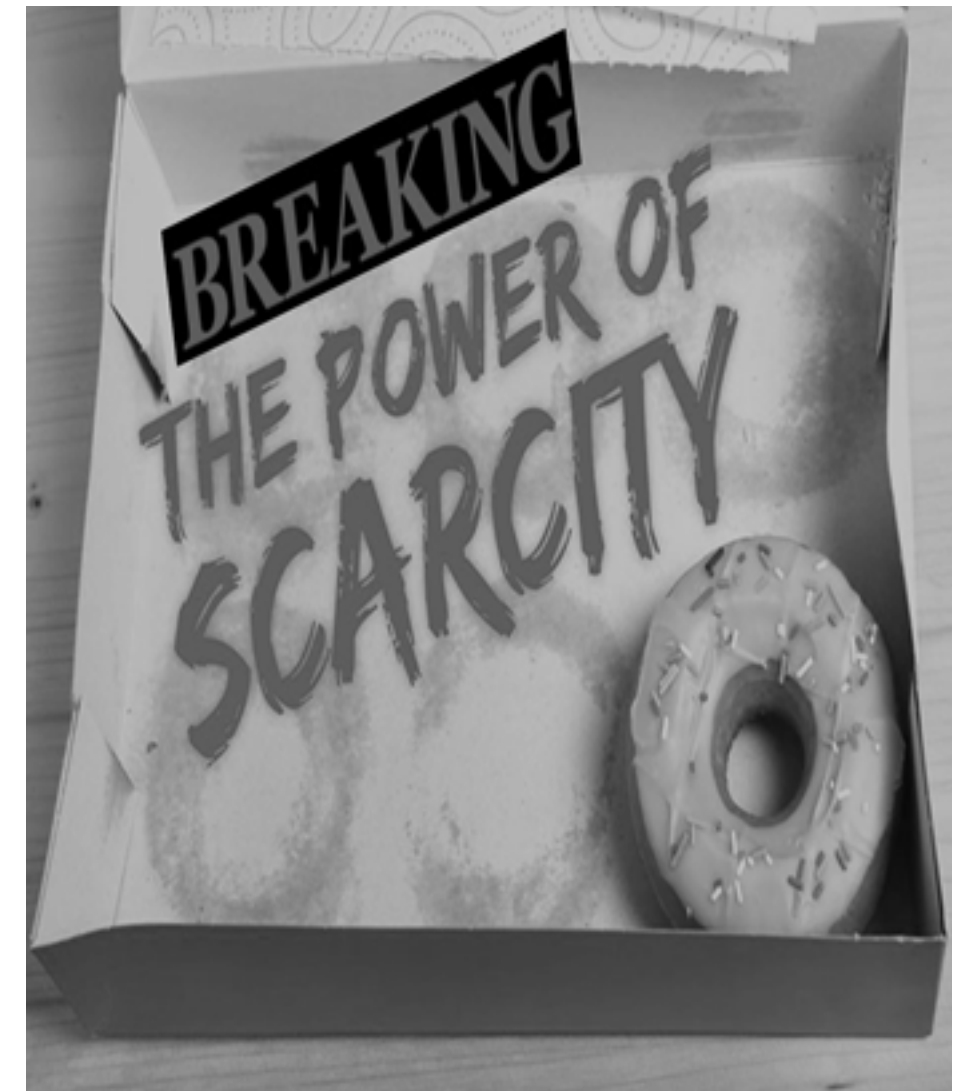
- YOUTH REP MEETING: We meet today at 5:00 pm! Bring your calendars and any dates that might help with our planning.
