⁷But whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. 8 What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ ⁹ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith. 10 I want to know Christ.

--Philippians 3:7-10a

That pretty much sums up the state of my soul at the start of 2018. I want to know Jesus Christ better in the New Year than ever before!

2) I am resolved to know the Gospel better in 2018.

The older I get the more I come to believe that Jesus followers never grow beyond the gospel; we are to continually grow deeper into the gospel. Do you know the Gospel?

One of the simplest presentations I am aware of comes from the Apostle Paul: ¹ Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. 2 By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

³ For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, 5 and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve.

--1 Corinthians 15:1-5

Jesus died for our sins and was raised for our eternal salvation. That is good

3) I am resolved to know God's grace better in 2018.

Some years ago, I was interviewed by an elementary school student for a class project. One of the questions she asked me was, "What is your favorite Bible verse?" I thought for a moment, and then replied, "The one that best captures my passion and purpose in life is Acts 20:24." Do you know that Bible verse? It goes like this:

²⁴ However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the good news of God's grace.

These words from the Apostle Paul continue to inspire and guide me through life. I am committed to finishing the race and completing the task Jesus has given me, and I know that the heart of that is to "testify to the good news of God's grace."

I know my list of 2018 resolutions will get longer than just **these** three, but that's a pretty good start, don't you think?
